
Teaching the Faith at Home Tips and Ideas

Ideas for Children ages 0-18



Children ages 0-1

- Read Bible Story books to the child
- Listen to Christian songs at home and in the car
- Pray out loud for/with your child at mealtime and bedtime. Other good times could be in the car or on a walk.
- Child sees parents interacting with other people around them in their church and home. This helps the child to learn hospitality, and how to love those around us.




Children ages 0-1

- Bible Story book examples:
 - A Child's Garden of Bible
 Stories
 - Arch Books
- Christian Music Options:
 - 100.7 and 90.5fm
 - Stream Christian playlists
- Pray by saying thank you Jesus, please help me Jesus and whatever else you want to add
- Introduce child to those who work at the church or/and some of your friends at church

Children ages 2-3

- Read Bible Story books and have child identify things in the pictures and story
- Go through a Family Devotion
- Sing songs with child and child learns to sing along
- Teach child common meal and/or bedtime prayers
- Introduce child to people at church so the child knows others at church beyond just their household.



Children ages 2-3

- Bible Story books:
 - My First Hands-On Bible
 - First 100: First 100 Bible Words
 - The Story Bible
- Family Devotion:
 - Little Visits with God Toddler Edition
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
- Songs:
 - Jesus Love Me
 - My God is So Big
 - This Little Light of Mine
- Prayers:
 - Come Lord Jesus
 - Oh Give Thanks
 - Now I Lay Me
- People at Church:
 - Other children their age and older
 - Children's Message Leaders
 - Musicians

Children grades PreK-K

- Read Bible Story books and answer basic questions about it
- Attend Refuel weekly
- Retell 5 or more Bible Stories
- Sing familiar songs during Worship
- Pray mealtime and bedtime prayers with help
- Say a "thank you" and a "please help me" to pray about each night
- Remind child that Jesus loves them and child can remind family members of this as well
- Volunteer with family at church

Children grades PreK-K

- Bible Story books:
 - 120 Bible Stories
 - The Story Bible
- Bible Story Questions:
 - What happened?
- Family Devotion:
 - Little Visits with God
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - My Devotions
- Songs:
 - Jesus Love Me, etc.
 - Worship songs and hymns that are meaningful for your family
- Prayers:
 - Common Written Prayers
 - Please and Thank You Prayers
- Help Volunteer at Church:
 - Pass out bulletins
 - Help ushers with offering
 - Help clean up leaves

Children grades 1st-2nd

- Read Bible Story books with help and begin reading on their own
- Attend Refuel Weekly
- Remember the main point of the Refuel Lesson and a summary of it
- Sing familiar songs during Worship and at home
- Say a short prayer when given or giving a prompt and common prayers
- Give words of encouragement and forgiveness to others
- Child becomes more independent at worship with participating and listening
- Volunteer with family at church

Children grades 1st-2nd


- Bible Story books:
 - 120 Bible Stories
 - The Story Bible
- Family Devotion:
 - Little Visits with God
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - My Devotions
- Refuel:
 - Ask child: what person did you hear about from the Bible at Refuel tonight?
- Songs:
 - Worship songs and hymns that are meaningful for your family
- Prayers:
 - Common Written Prayer
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
- Help Volunteer at Church:
 - Pass out bulletins
 - Help ushers with offering
 - Help clean up leaves
 - Etc.

Children grades 3-4

- Alternate between listening to and reading the Bible for themselves
- Attend Refuel Weekly and can explain what they learned about
- Identify (with help) how they can serve others with their gifts and talents
- Sing songs during Worship and at home
- Memorize the books of the Bible
- Say a short prayer with a prompt or follow a prayer model
- Give words of encouragement and forgiveness to others
- Child participates in Worship through songs, prayers, and listening
- Volunteer with family at church
- Share Jesus' love with others and invite friends and family to worship

Children grades 3-4

- Bible:
 - Have child begin reading Scripture from the NLT or a Children's Bible Translation
- Family Devotion:
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - My Devotions
 - Lutheran Hour Daily Devotions
- Refuel:
 - Ask child: what person did you hear about from the Bible at Refuel tonight? How do you think that person felt?
- Prayers
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
 - Prayer Models: ACTS, 5 Finger Prayer, etc
- Help Volunteer at Church:
 - Pass out bulletins
 - Help ushers with offering
 - Help clean up leaves
 - Etc.



Children grades 5-6

- Participate and help lead family devotions along with personal devotion time (read, think, write, pray)
- Attend Refuel Weekly and can explain what they learned about & apply it
- Identify how they can serve others with their gifts and talents
- Participate in each part of Worship
- Read the Bible on their own and follow a Reading plan
- Pray independently and out loud
- See when others need encouragement and forgiveness and extend it to them
- Volunteer with family at church
- Share Jesus' love with others and invite friends and family to worship & home

Children grades 5-6

Resources and Starting Points

- Bible:
 - Have child begin reading Scripture from the New Living Translation Bible
 - Read a Gospel in 1 Month
 - YouVersion Bible App Reading Plans
- Family Devotion:
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - Advent/Lent Devotionals
 - Lutheran Hour Daily Devotions

Refuel:

- Ask child: what person did you hear about from the Bible at Refuel tonight? How do you think that person felt? How does it connect with other parts of the Bible?
- Prayers
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
 - Prayer Models: ACTS, 5 Finger Prayer, etc.
- Help Volunteer at Church:
 - Learn how to do the screens or sound
 - Help a parent with the coffee bar
 - Etc.

Children grades 7-8

- Participate and help lead family devotions along with personal devotion time (read, think, write, pray)
- Attend Confirmation weekly
- Attend Bible Study twice or more a month
- Identify how they can serve others with their gifts and talents in the church and throughout the world
- Participate in each part of Worship & take sermon notes
- Read the Bible on their own and follow a Reading plan
- Pray independently and out loud
- See when others need encouragement and forgiveness and extend it to them
- Volunteer with family at church
- Share Jesus' love with others and invite friends and family to worship & home

Children grades 7-8

- Bible:
 - Have child begin reading Scripture from the New Living Translation Bible
 - Read a Gospel in 1 Month
 - YouVersion Bible App Reading Plans
- Family Devotion:
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - Advent/Lent Devotionals
 - Lutheran Hour Daily Devotions
- Confirmation:
 - Ask child about the topic/theme and have them explain it.
 - Do Confirmation Family Time Weekly
- Prayers
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
 - Prayer Models: ACTS, 5 Finger Prayer, etc.
- Volunteer at Church:
 - Help with the screens or sound
 - Help with the coffee bar
 - Etc.

Children grades 9-10

- Participate and help lead family devotions along with personal devotion time (read, think, write, pray)
- Attend small group weekly & large group monthly
- Serve others with their gifts and talents in the church and throughout the community
- Participate in each part of Worship & take notes to help remember, take Communion as often as possible
- Read the Bible on their own and follow a Reading plan
- Pray independently and out loud and pray one-on-one with others
- See when others need encouragement and forgiveness and extend it to them
- Volunteer with family at church
- Share Jesus' love with others and invite friends and family to worship & home

Children grades 9-10

- Bible:
 - Have child begin reading Scripture from the New Living Translation and ESV Bible
 - Read a chapter of Scripture each day
 - YouVersion Bible App Reading Plans
- Family Devotion:
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - Advent/Lent Devotionals
 - Lutheran Hour Daily Devotions
- Small/Large Group Check In:
 - Ask child what their lesson/topic was
 - Encourage student to attend each week
 - Encourage student to participate in FCA
- Prayers
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
 - Prayer Models: ACTS, PRAY, etc.
- Volunteer at Church:
 - Help with the screens or sound
 - Help with the coffee bar
 - Etc.

Children grades 11-12

- Participate and help lead family devotions along with personal devotion time (read, think, write, pray)
- Attend small group weekly & large group monthly
- Serve others with their gifts and talents in the church and throughout the community
- Participate in each part of Worship & take notes to help remember, take Communion as often as possible; apply what they hear to their lives
- Read the Bible on their own and follow a Reading plan
- Pray independently and out loud and pray one-on-one with others
- See when others need encouragement and forgiveness and extend it to them
- Volunteer with family at church
- Share Jesus' love with others and invite friends and family to worship & home

Children grades 11-12

- Bible:
 - Have child begin reading Scripture from the New Living Translation and ESV Bible
 - Read a chapter of Scripture each day
 - YouVersion Bible App Reading Plans
- Family Devotion:
 - Enduring Faith Calendar
 - Advent/Lent Devotionals
 - Lutheran Hour Daily Devotions
- Small/Large Group Check In:
 - Ask child what their lesson/topic was
 - Encourage student to attend each week
 - Encourage student to participate in FCA
- Prayers
 - Prayer Prompts: friends, family, nation, etc.
 - Prayer Models: ACTS, PRAY, etc.
- Volunteer at Church:
 - Help with the screens or sound
 - Help with the coffee bar
 - Etc.
