

Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." John 1:46

As a kid, I would enjoy when missionaries would come to the church to speak about sharing Jesus with the people of Chad, Cameroon, Taiwan, or some other far-off land. I would dream of doing that someday, but was uncertain about leaving my home to learn another language, another culture, and giving up all I had. Maybe for a week or two, but not for years.

That is how most of us picture a missionary, isn't it? But God has called each of us to be a missionary wherever we live, to the people around us! As our society becomes less "Christian" in belief and in practice, we have a huge opportunity in front of us to be missionaries in our hometown. 
Finally, you can purchase the book to dig in even deeper. Let the church office know if you'd
