

Our Bible reading talks about how our faith makes us right with God and how we are set free from our sins through Jesus' death and resurrection!

*Read Romans 3:22-26, NLT is included in this but you are welcome to read whatever version you would like.*

We just heard that everyone in the world sins. Because God knows that we all sin and can't do anything to help ourselves, He sent Jesus! When Jesus came to Earth, He took on all of your sins and the sins of everyone in the world. This Bible reading uses two words to describe God in verse 26, it says that God is fair and just. What do you think it means that God is fair and just? *Discuss this.* One way to describe being fair and just is to say that God is trustworthy. This means that when we hear that God has forgiven us because of Jesus, we can trust Him and believe that this is true!

This Bible passage also talks a lot how we are made right in God's sight. Hearing this might be a little bit confusing so let's see what this means. Have you ever seen a movie in 3D? How is it different than seeing a normal movie? What do you have to put on to see the movie in 3D? *Discuss This.* When we are made right in God's sight, it's like God put on glasses like you do when you see a movie in 3D. But, these glasses are different than the ones at the movies. These glasses make it so that when God looks at you, He doesn't see any sins! Instead, God sees Jesus and how He lived a perfect life and died and rose again for you! Jesus' death and resurrection are how you are made right in God's sight.

Prayer: Dear God, Thank You for making me right in Your sight. Thank You for seeing Jesus' perfect life instead of seeing my sin when You look at me. Help me to trust You and believe what You teach me in the Bible. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
